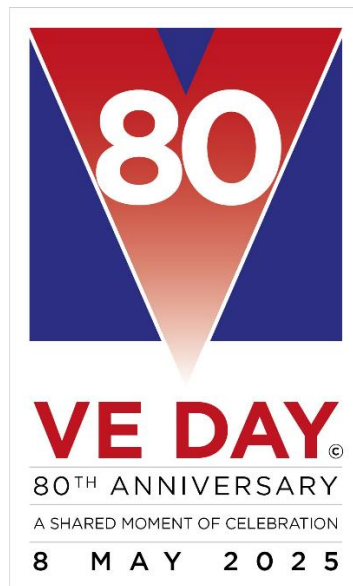




Annwyl Glerc/Cadeirydd y Cyngor,

CANLLAWIAU I GYMRYD RHAN DYDD VE 80: Mae'r Arweinlyfr yn amlinellu rhai o'r gweithgareddau amrywiol rydym yn eich annog chi a'ch cymuned i gymryd rhan ynddynt, yn bennaf goleuo'r Bannau a 'Lamp Lights of Peace' am **9.30pm**, gyda'r fflamau o'r ddau yn cynrychioli'r 'golau heddwch' a ddeilliodd o dywyllwch ofnadwy rhyfel yr holl flynyddoedd yn ôl, a gostiodd gymaint o filiynau o fywydau i'w gyflawni, (milwrol a sifil), yn ogystal ag annog ein Cenedl fawr i fwyta 'Pysgod a Sglodion' fel rhan o hyn. digwyddiad y diwrnod hwnnw, yn ein 'teyrnged' ar y cyd i'r Pysgotwr rhyfeddol a dewr a oedd yn dal i bysgota'r moroedd yn gorfod osgoi'r pyllau glo a osodwyd o amgylch ein glannau yn gyson, a'r ffermwyr anhunanol a Merched y Tir a aredig i gaeau gan gadw'r Genedl yn ymborth, heb wybod pe byddai anwyliaid byth yn dychwelyd. (Roedd Pysgod a Sglodion yn un o fwydydd sefydledig ein Cenhedloedd na chafodd ei ddogni gan y Prif Weinidog Winston Churchill).

Gogledd Iwerddon, Lloegr, Ynysoedd y Sianel ac Ynys Manaw, i ganu eu clychau i ddathlu'r hyn a gyflawnwyd ar 8 Mai 1945, am 6.30pm ar 8 Mai y flwyddyn nesaf.

If you have already registered your involvement in VE Day 80 - 8th May 2025, please be kind enough to delete this email, as we will be making contact with you again with final arrangements during the latter part of April next year.

However, those that have not yet confirmed their participation, I would like to take this opportunity to re-confirm the plans for VE Day 80, outlining the following aspects of what will be taking place on 8th May 2025, in celebration of this important Anniversary, providing those throughout Wales to pay their personal, group and community 'tribute' to the 300.000 plus brave souls from Wales that gave so much fighting for peace we all enjoy today - "Less We Forget".

With this in mind, I have pleasure in attaching and confirming the following:

VE DAY 80 GUIDE TO TAKING PART: The Guide outlines some of the various activities we are encouraging you and your community to take part in, mainly the lighting of Beacons and Lamp Lights of Peace at **9.30pm**, with the flames from both representing the 'light of peace' that emerged from the dreadful darkness of war all those years ago, which cost so many millions of lives achieving it, (military and civilian), as well as encouraging our great Nation to eat of Fish and Chips as part of this event that day, in our collective 'tribute' to the amazing and brave Fisherman that still fished the seas having to constantly avoid the mines laid around our shores, and the selfless farmers and Land Girls that ploughed to fields keeping the Nation fed, not knowing if loved ones would ever return. (Fish and Chips was one of our Nations established foods that was not rationed by Prime Minister Winston Churchill).

RINGING OUT IN CELEBRATION - 6.30PM: As I am sure you will agree with me when I say, the ringing of church bells throughout our **world** have always been such important part of our national and international occasions, celebrating and marking unique moments in history, so it is only fitting we are encouraging all Cathedrals and Churches of all denominations throughout
